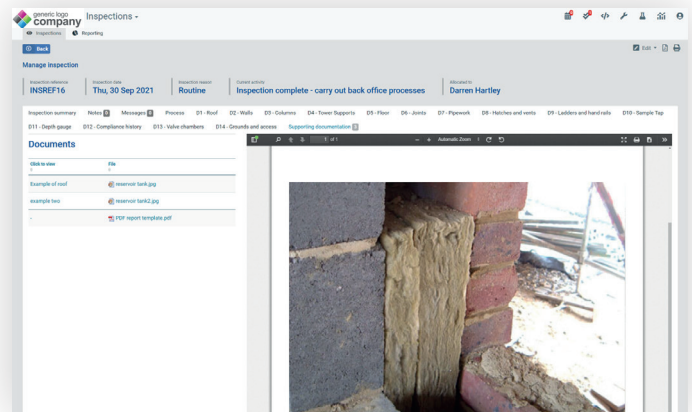
New questions
